Teachers for LaMirada Camp June 3rd to July 26th

Florida certified teachers needed for part-time summer day camp for our new program at LaMirada from 8am-1:30pm. Y camp programs are a fun, exciting place for kids to spend their summer days. We're looking for two (2) talented & caring teachers to plan developmentally appropriate activities and experiences. Ensuring all campers are kept safe while building a sense of community within the camp along with meeting the needs of the individual with dignity and respect, culminating in a positive impact on the lives of our campers. Weekly activities include group games, sports, swimming, reading, arts & crafts and much more. Campers age range from 1st graders to 8th graders.

- Must be a certified teacher as appointed by Florida State guidelines.
- Must have basic understanding of child development and able to plan and carry out developmentally appropriate activities.
- Must be able to swim.
- Must be physically capable of lifting 40 lbs.
- Must be able to lead campers in games, sing songs, lead a variety of sports, assist campers with their arts & craft projects plus focus on values & character building.
- Be responsible for the safety & supervision of your assigned group of campers.
- Must be able to work with youth & families from a variety of socioeconomic backgrounds.
- Must be able to work independently & as part of a team.
- Must be able to pass a Level II screening (fingerprint) & drug screening.
- Must complete CPR/AED-Pro & First Aid certification, required Redwoods online training & required camp training prior to the first day of camp.
- Must practice the YMCA core values of caring, honesty, respect & responsibility at all times.

We're looking for talented & caring counselors to lead & guide campers so they'll have a meaningful experience & make a positive impact in their lives through our day-to-day programs. Weekly activities include group games, sports, arts & crafts, Character development, reading and more. Camp participants age range from 1st graders to 8th graders.

- Must be 18 years of age.
- Energetic, patient & creative.
- Must be able to lead campers in games, sing songs, lead a variety of sports, assist campers with their arts & craft projects plus focus on values & character building.
- For the LaMirada camp, counselors must be able to swim.
- Be responsible for the safety & supervision of your assigned group of campers.
- Must be able to work with youth & families from a variety of socioeconomic backgrounds.
- Must be able to work independently & as part of a team.
- Must be physically capable of lifting 40 lbs.
- Must be able to pass a Level II screening (fingerprint) & drug screening.
- Must complete CPR/AED-Pro & First Aid certification, required Redwoods online training & required camp training prior to the first day of camp.
- Must practice the YMCA core values of caring, honesty, respect & responsibility at all times.

Lifeguards For LaMirada Camp

Two Certified part-time lifeguards will be needed Tuesday/Thursday for 3 hours for the LaMirada Camp. Must be reliable & focused to ensure the safety of all participants in the aquatics environment at all times. Maintain a professional appearance, follow dress code, arrive on time for your shift & follow Y policies & procedures.

- o Must be at least 18 years of age with either YMCA, American Red Cross or ASHI Lifeguard certification plus CPR/AED-Pro & First Aid.
- o Must be able to perform strenuous physical tasks necessary for a water rescue.
- o Knows/reviews all emergency procedures & responds to emergency situations immediately in accordance with YMCA policies & procedures & completes related reports as required.
- o Adequate ability to hear noises & distinguish distress signals.
- o Must be able to communicate verbally, including projecting your voice across a distance in normal & loud situations.
- o Must be able to stay alert & able to sit or stand for an extended period of time.
- o Ability to continuously scan all areas of the pool with clear vision.
- o Must be able to work with all types of individuals while carrying out the YMCA core values of honesty, caring, respect & responsibility.
- o Must be dependable & flexible.
- o Must complete required Redwoods training & attend New Hire Orientation within 30 days of hire.

Swim Lessons Instructor For LaMirada Camp

Two Certified part-time swim instructors needed Tuesday/Thursday for 3 hours for the LaMirada Camp. Teach group swimming lessons to camp participants by following the YMCA teaching standards & procedures. Instructors must work & communicate effectively with children & adults, maintain order & ensure the safety of all participants. Maintain records of skills, attendance & student progress on rosters & skill sheets. Complete all student progress reports & certificates as required & aid in communicating this information effectively with parents. Ensure all aquatics equipment brought in for camp is maintained properly & report broken or damaged equipment to the program director timely. Maintain a professional appearance, follow dress code, arrive on time for your shift & follow Y policies & procedures.

- o Must be at least 17 years of age with a swimming ability of Minnow level or higher with a minimum of one year experience teaching YMCA swim lessons program or previous swim lessons teaching experience.
- o Current CPR/AED-Pro, First Aid & Oxygen Administration or complete prior the start of camp.
- o Current certification in YMCA Swim Lessons Instructor or completion within one year of hire.
- o Must be able to move to various locations, including in & around an elevated chair.
- o Communicate verbally, including projecting the voice across distances.
- o Hear noises & distress signals & observe all area of the water area.
- o Able to perform all needed rescues & survival skills.
- o Think in abstract, solve problems, make sound decisions, instruct, evaluate, supervise & remember.
- o Must be able to work with all types of individuals while carrying out the YMCA core values of honesty, caring, respect & responsibility.
- o Must be dependable & flexible.

Site Director

The responsibility of the site director is to plan developmentally appropriate activities and experiences for the children in a safe manner; schedule and supervise the support staff after school sessions; plan with your staff a written lesson plan and schedule of activities each month; ensure program supplies needed are on hand, equipment being used is functioning as needed and report any needs and issues to DASH Director promptly. The site director is responsible for the safety of participants and staff within the program through ongoing training and reinforcement of policies and procedures. Ensure

excellent communication and courteous behavior between staff, students, parents and community. Must plan and implement at least two community recognition events each school year; write and create twice a year, a Parent/Student Newsletter and plan and implement annual fund raiser. The site Director is responsible for new employee orientation at the site and the processing of semi-monthly time sheets for payroll. Must collect child care tuition payments when due, whether weekly or quarterly payments. But most of all, make sure the children are challenged in the programs to learn, grow and have fun. This site director will meet the Y school bus at Freedom, Gullette and McNeal to ensure the correct children get on the bus to be transported to the branch.

- Must be 21 years of age and able to meet pre-employment and drug screening requirements.
- Prefer a certified teacher as appointed by Florida State Guidelines.
- Be able and willing to work with all children regardless of age, sex, race, religion, family background or ability.
- Must understand and be able to teach children the concepts of mutual respect, caring honesty and responsibility.
- Be patient and able to make sound judgments while interacting with children in a timely manner on a daily basis.
- Must be able to communicate, train and mentor staff on an ongoing basis.
- Have the ability to be flexible and to be open to new ideas and changes that enhance the program quality.
- Ensure YMCA Child Care Policy and Procedures are made common knowledge and followed at all times.
- Must read, know and sign the YMCA child Abuse Pamphlet, Employee Policy Handbook and Staff Pledge.
- Able to handle stressful situation in a positive manner.
- Have physical capability to lift 40 pounds; listen and observe children at all times; stand and/or sit for extended period of time; stoop, bend, reach, kneel and able to quickly reach a child and/ or situation to prevent harm.
- Must have current ASHI CPR/AED-Pro and First Aid certification or obtain within 30 days of hire.
- Must complete required Redwoods Risk Management online training and attend New Hire Orientation within 30 days of hire.

Support Staff

The Y-DASH program will need Support Staff for the new After School Child Care program at the Lakewood Ranch Branch. Must be responsible and outgoing, a relationship builder, a communicator and willing to interact positively with the children, parents, school personnel and Y staff. You will greet parents and children with a smile; supervise homework time, plan and initiate activities and experiences with the children in a safe environment. Shift is 3:30pm-6pm, Monday through Friday.


- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Capable of lifting 40 pounds.
- Have a basic understanding of child development.
- Must be prompt and reliable.
- Must adhere to all attendance, child abuse and staff policies and procedures.
- Able to pass a level II (fingerprint) and drug screening.
- Must have or complete within 30 days of hire, CPR/AED-Pro and First Aid certification.
- Must complete Redwoods Risk Management online training and attend New Hire Orientation within 30 days of hire.
